Vendor Agreement for November 17, 2007

Welcome to the Russell Moore Music Fest. Thank you for your interest in being a part of this great event. This is an opportunity to share your artworks or tasty food with many visitors. The music fest location is at the **Rawhide Pavilion at Wild Horse Pass**. The address for Rawhide is 5700 West North Loop Rd, Chandler, AZ 85226 Phone: 480-502-5600 or 800-527-1880. The Pavilion is next to Wild Horse Pass Casino, I-10 West Exit 162. This event is on the Gila River Indian Community (GRIC).

- **Gila River Artist Market** part of the Pee-Posh Project (GRIC tribal members only)
 - Contact Yolanda Hart Stevens, Pee-Posh Project 602/826-2280
 - Gila River Artist Market location on the North end of Pavilion
 - A separate application need to be filled out for the Pee-Posh Project
- **Food vendors** for the general public to apply for:
 - Must have GRIC food handlers permit (different than Maricopa county) contact the Gila River Indian Community for information on the food handlers permit at 520/562-5100 (any other food handlers permit not acceptable).
 - Must have GRIC business license (contact GRIC at 520/562-9500 for license)
 - Vendor site will be designated in on the grassy area of the Rawhide Pavilion.
- **Art/Craft Vendors** RMMF Artist Market for the general public to apply for:
 - Must have GRIC business license (contact GRIC at 520/562-9500 for license)
 - Must sell their own arts/crafts,
 - will set up on the South end inside the Rawhide Pavilion
- Information Entertainer vendors will have fee waived approved by RMMF committee.
- Setup begins at 9am on Saturday, November 17
- Art/Craft fair starts at 10am till 6pm, take down and removal begins at 6pm
- Food and craft vendors booth fee of \$50 (fifty dollars), with the exception of the art vendors under the Pee-Posh Project.
- **Vendors must show their GRIC business license and/or GRIC food handlers permit.** Arizona state business license not acceptable, must be GRIC business license. Contact GRIC the Revenue & Internal Audit Dept and request either a Special Event License (good for 5 days \$30) or a Regular business license good for one year at \$150.

All vending spaces are 10 feet long by 10 feet wide and are assigned at the sole discretion of the Russell Moore Music Fest Committee.

Terms and Regulations:

- Vendor must be in compliance with the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-644), which prohibits misrepresentation in marketing of Indian arts and crafts products within the United States. The Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 is a truth-in advertising law. It is illegal to offer or display for sale, or sell any art or craft product in a manner that falsely suggests it is Indian produced, an Indian product, or the product of a particular Indian tribe.
- All items for sale must be made by the applicant. Authenticity of work will be reviewed by RMMF committee.
- Vendors are required to provide their own set up and removal of their equipment. Vendors will bring their own table(s) and chair(s).
- Vendors agree that the Russell Moore Music Fest is not responsible whatsoever of any loss or damage to vendor's equipment, supplies, goods, or other property.
- Vendors will dispose of their own garbage at designated areas on site at Rawhide.
- Food vendors will dispose of their grease/oil in the grease disposal by the Rawhide Restaurant (behind the steak house).
- Vendors accept the decision of the RMMF Committee in disputes between vendor and any other festival participant or any other matter not covered by this agreement.
- Vendors shall not sublet, assign or donate allotted space, in whole or in part. Vendors shall occupy only the assigned space.
- Vendors should have adequate protection for inclement weather, the sun and heat.
- Vendors may not sell or consume alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.
- Vendors accept that at anytime the agreement can be terminated between the RMMF committee and vendor upon a breach. Upon termination, vendors shall have no rights and the RMMF committee shall have no obligations under the agreement.
- Vendors accept that the music fest is a family event which is drug and alcohol free.
- If vendors violate any of these terms, they will be asked to leave the event.
